Giving in to his cravings, the gambler lights up another card. The six of spades does its job, but is not enough. He hits again.



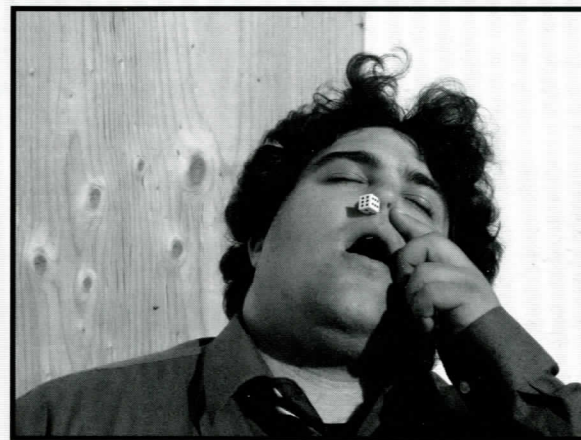
The gambler asks his dealer to deal him a full deck. The dealer checks the coast is clear, aware of the cost of busting.



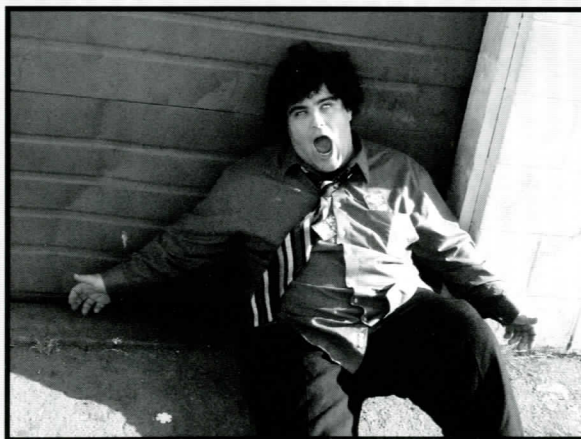
The addict suspects the deck has been cut. "Of course it has!" reminds the dealer.

CAPULET MAN: He chok'd!

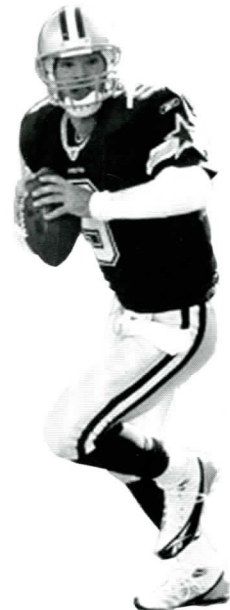
BENVOLIO: Mercutio's augury has come to pass!

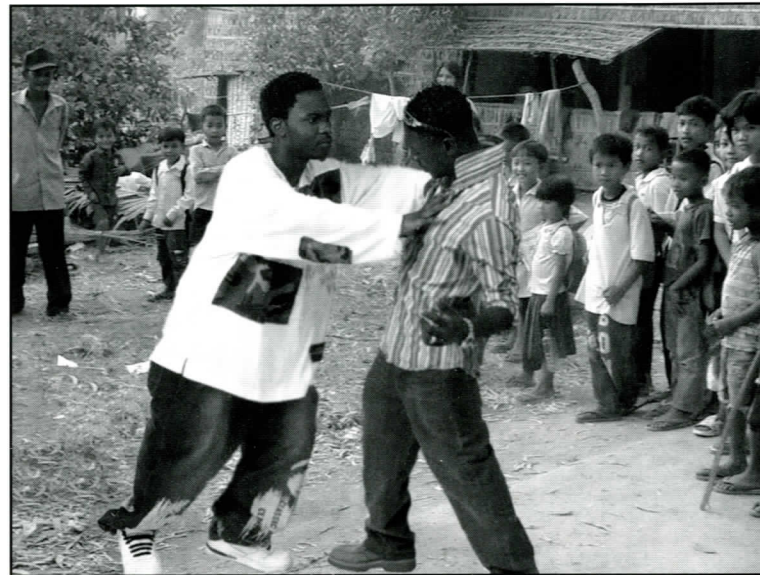
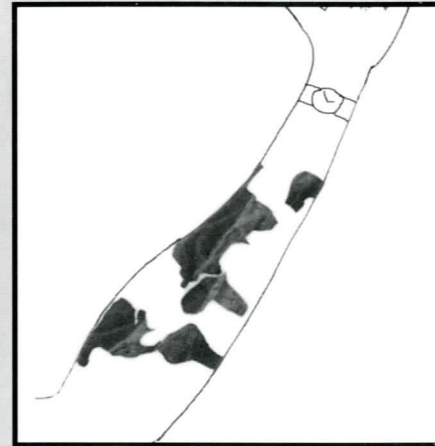
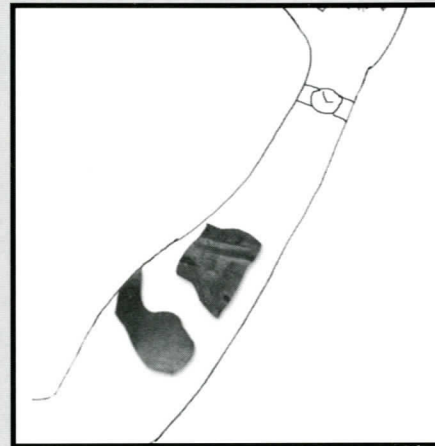
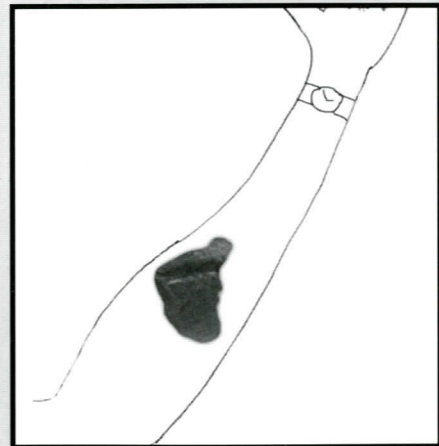


Figure 1: A group of Nicaraguan children watch an after-school dawg fight put on by their local government.
